The Kinderhook Memorial Library provides free broadband wireless Internet access twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Users are expected to use the wireless network in a legal and responsible manner. Violation of local, state or federal laws is prohibited.

Wireless access at the Library is not filtered. By choosing to use this free wireless service, patrons agree to abide by the Library's Computer & Equipment Use Policy, the Internet Access Policy, and the Patron Code of Conduct & Patron Responsibilities Policy. Patrons must also adhere to New York State Penal Law regarding the retrieval or display of graphics that may be construed as obscene.

Wireless Internet Security:

As with most public wireless networks, a wireless internet connection is not secure. Any information sent to and from your notebook/laptop computer or other wireless device may be captured by anyone else with a wireless device and the appropriate software. Wireless users who choose to transmit their credit card numbers, passwords or other sensitive personal information while using the Library's wireless network do so at their own risk.

The Library is not responsible for any information that is compromised, or for any damage caused to an individual's hardware or software due to electric surges, security issues, viruses, hacking, spamming, or other causes.

The Library assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment or for computer, or other wireless device configurations, security, or data files resulting from connection to the Library wireless network.

Any use of the Kinderhook Memorial Library wireless network that exerts an exorbitant strain on the Library's network and compromises patron and staff use is not allowed.

Filtering:

The Library's wireless internet access is not filtered in accordance with the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA) and, as noted above, the wireless network is not secure.

Use of the library's wireless network is entirely at the risk of the user. The library disclaims all liability for loss of confidential information or damages resulting from that loss.

Printing using the wireless network:

Printing access is not available via the Wi-Fi network. If the user desires to print, the file can be saved to a flash/thumb drive or emailed to themselves and printed from one of the library's public computer.

Equipment Responsibility:

The library assumes no responsibility for damage to or loss of equipment; users must keep their equipment with them at all times.

Using power outlets:

Available power outlets may be used wherever the cord does not present a tripping hazard or block access for patrons or staff. It is recommended that you charge your battery before coming to the library.
